WE'VE GOT GAME!

THE MISSION of the *Northern Virginia Junior Catholic Youth Organization* (NVJCYO) is to organize sports programs for parish youth in grades 3 through 8, throughout the Diocese of Arlington, to reinforce Catholic values taught in parish schools and religious education programs. It is an important component of the comprehensive approach to youth ministry in the Diocese. The programs are meant not only to encourage healthy physical activity but also to play a significant role in the development of Catholic values in our youth. These activities foster team spirit, cooperation, respect, sportsmanship, responsibility, leadership, competitiveness, fairness and courtesy.

All Saints sports are open to students who attend Sacred Heart, Seton or All Saints schools, or are homeschooled. Also, those enrolled in Religious Education at Holy Trinity, All Saints, or a home-school RE program approved by All Saints. Medical and liability releases and a signed code of conduct form are required for each participant.



BASKETBALL: Practices are held in October and November and games begin in December. After the holidays, games continue through February. Fifth- and Eighth-grade teams have Play-off games in March.

TRACK & FIELD: There are two seasons, Fall and Spring, and two meets. Meets are held at Bishop O'Connell HS. The Varsity and Junior Varsity teams (5th-8th graders) compete on Saturday; and the Freshman teams (3rd-4th graders) on Sunday. Practices are held on Sundays (1:30-3pm) and Wednesdays (5:30 until dark) at Manassas Baptist Church's track (behind the old elementary school).

CROSS COUNTRY: There are three meets: two developmental meets (at Fort Hunt Park in Alexandria and Laurel Hill Park in Lorton) and the championship meet at Burke Lake Park. Practices are held on Sundays (1:30-3pm) at Manassas Battlefield/Stone House, and Wednesdays (5:30 until dark) at Manassas Baptist Church's track (behind the old elementary school).

CHEERLEADING: Open to 4th-8th graders. Cheerleaders participate in the All Saints School Pep Rally, the Manassas Christmas Parade, and during the basketball season. There is also an annual exhibition held in late winter.

VOLLEYBALL: Practices and matches are held in the Spring. The league is now three seasons old and highly competitive, now with skill divisions for both the 7/8 grade and 5/6 grade leagues. Details of the Sprint season should be available in March 2017.

COACHING STAFF: Inasmuch as JCYO Sports are wonderful for our youngsters, teaching teamwork, sportsmanship, and fair competition, as described above, our program would be *nothing* without the volunteer efforts of our coaches and administrators! At no time may a Participant:

- Approach an official, a timekeeper, or a scorekeeper in a confrontational manner.
- Engage in unsportsmanlike conduct towards the opposing team’s players, coaches, or spectators, including negative cheering, yelling, or causing a distraction during game play.
- Eat or drink in the gym.
- Engage in any horseplay or other activities during a team practice or game at any facility, including but not limited to the practice/playing court/track, on top of- or under- the bleachers; in hallways; foyers; restrooms; stages; or on facility grounds or parking lots.
- Congregate in the playing area, near team benches, or in the foyer of the gym once their game is completed (blocking the next teams from beginning their game).
