At All Saints we are blessed with a strong and active Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) focused on two clear objectives: fostering a sense of community among the families in our school and raising funds in support of school initiatives.

General Assembly Meetings of the PTO are held four times per year and include informational sessions on a variety of topics.
