Principal's Message

The safety of your children is always a top priority at All Saints. In recent years, in accordance with national initiatives and diocesan policy, we have taken additional steps to do our part to ensure that your children are in a safe place when they are participating in a program at All Saints Catholic School. The *Formation in Christian Chastity Program* is one part of our commitment to establishing and maintaining a safe environment for our students. As outlined in the materials, information is provided primarily to parents as a resource to be used in the formation of their children. There is one classroom lesson for students in grades one through four and two lessons for those in grades five through eight.

We will be integrating the objectives of the program into our religion lessons during the next three weeks beginning on Monday, September 11th. The entire curriculum can be accessed through the diocesan website: www.arlingtondiocese.org. (Click on the Protecting Our Children tab at the top of the homepage. To view the grade level lesson plans, click on Youth Training Programs followed by the *Formation in Christian Chastity Program.*)

You are encouraged to spend some time reviewing this information yourself and to then share pertinent aspects with your children. Each of the lessons contains some application to common sense safety tips that you may wish to share with your children. Other parts of the resources apply to some of the decisions that you make as parents for the safety of your children. Our goal is to equip both you and your children with the knowledge that can help to keep them safe.

The essential point is that parents need to be involved with their children. The more you know about the daily events of your child's life, the better you are able to spot any danger signs that may surface. The more regular communication you have with your children, the freer they are to come to you with their concerns.

Should you have any questions about the *Formation in Christian Chastity Program* or about the classroom lessons, please do not hesitate to let us know. In the event that

you would prefer to not have your child participate in the classroom training, please contact the front office to request an opt-out form.

Fall Picture Day (Monday, September 11th)

Two years ago the decision was made to host only one picture day per year in an effort to reduce costs for parents and to streamline our schedule. <u>Based on feedback</u> received from parents last year and so as to provide a little variety from one year to the next, students are invited to dress-up for Fall Picture Day on Monday.

Although Splendid Portraits is now part of Lifetouch, a large school picture company, this change will have little impact on the scheduling, process and pricing of our existing program.

<u>Criminal Background Checks for Volunteers & VIRTUS Requirements</u>

As part of the diocesan initiative to maintain a safe environment for all of our children, all volunteers with children are required to complete a background check prior to working in the school and to complete VIRTUS training within 45 days of commencing service. To register for an upcoming training, please visit www.virtus.org.

All parents who wish to attend field trips or volunteer in support of classroom activities are required to complete the background check process and attend VIRTUS training.

As we begin a new year, in accordance with diocesan policy, only those parents who have completed the criminal background check are eligible to volunteer in the school. Those who have not yet completed the background check process may request a packet of forms from the front office.
