Thank you to those parents who participated in the recent survey regarding preferences for exiting the front parking lot during afternoon dismissal. We have compiled the data and are now completing an analysis of how we might assign families to bays 1-3 based upon this information, all in the interest of creating an even more efficient process. Look for an update and additional details on this in the weeks ahead.

In the meantime, so as to maintain the flow of traffic on the streets surrounding the parish property, parents are reminded to make *only right turns* when entering and exiting during arrival and dismissal. Parents are also asked to be particularly mindful of other drivers on Stonewall Road, ensuring that the flow of traffic is able to continue unimpeded. If a line forms at the entrance to All Saints, be sure that sufficient space exists for other cars to pass. This will help us to maintain positive public relations with community members and local businesses.
