### Principal's Message

Yesterday our community celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Following the school Mass at 10:00 a.m., the students placed roses at the feet of the statue of Our Lady in the courtyard and recited a Decade of the Rosary in Spanish and English led by Fr. Juan and Fr. Noah. With the joyful singing of the parish Guadalupe Choir and delicious Mexican doughnuts for everyone to enjoy, it was a festive celebration of our faith and cultural heritage. I wish to extend a special word of thanks to the Spanish Choir who shared their musical gifts and to the Ventura Family for so generously donating the treats for our students and staff. I also want to thank Fr. Mauricio for his assistance in planning the celebration and Miss McPhilamy for coordinating a program of bi-lingual music during the liturgy.

Today I wish to provide an update regarding the recent challenges with our computer network and Internet connectivity. To date, our Internet provider has completed exterior repairs and replacement of equipment. Additionally, our IT team has partnered closely with the vendors responsible for our Wi-Fi hardware and firewall device. In short, many measures have been implemented, but we are unfortunately continuing to experience challenges with connectivity. Although the faculty and students are able to access the Internet, the connection is at times sporadic and download speeds are sluggish.

In recognition that this situation continues to impact student access to Accelerated Reader, the teachers in grades 2-5 have determined that students will not receive grades for completion of AR tests during the second quarter.

Our IT support team continues to troubleshoot the issues and are now consulting with another firm that began a high level analysis of our infrastructure last week. I am continuing to receive daily reports on the analysis of our network and the strategies being implemented. As this matter is resolved or additional impacts are anticipated, I will keep you apprised. Thank you for your patience as we continue to work through this challenge.
