Principal's Message

Happy New Year! I hope that you and your family enjoyed the Christmas holiday and the many opportunities to celebrate the season.

The second round of Scantron Testing will begin on Monday and extend through the next three weeks. The format will be identical to that of the first round, i.e. approximately one hour assessments in math, reading and language arts completed by students in grades 3-7.

Significant progress has been made regarding our computer network and the stability of our Internet connections over the course of the past several weeks. Nevertheless, to ensure an optimum testing environment for our students, we will be administering the Scantron assessment in the computer lab and library media center where many of the devices are hardwired and there is less dependency on our wireless network. In the days ahead, we will finalize the testing schedule and I'll forward a copy to you so that you can be aware of the days and times when your children will be completing the assessment.

The Gift of Human Sexuality Program – Parent Meeting (January 10 @ 7:00 p.m.)

All Saints Catholic School has implemented a middle school family life curriculum that supports our goal of educating the whole child. The program is coordinated by the Diocesan Director of Youth Ministry, Mr. Kevin Bohli, and is tailored to the specific needs of each school community. The program consists of a parent presentation during which Mr. Bohli provides an outline of his presentations as well as resources for parents. Following this presentation, he and an associate, Ms. Carmen Briceno, will meet with the students for three one hour lessons designed to provide the children with an understanding of the Church's teachings on the topic of human sexuality.

One of the advantages of this program is the involvement of outside professionals. In addition to their expertise and experience, Mr. Bohli and Ms.Briceno are unfamiliar to the students, which may put the students at greater ease in asking questions and discussing this topic. A second advantage of this program is that it is designed to take place in a single-sex setting; Mr. Bohli will address the boys and Ms. Briceno will speak with the girls. Finally, in accordance with diocesan policy, this program is designed as

an opt-in opportunity for parents and students. Accommodations will be made for those children whose parents prefer that they not participate in the program.

Parents of middle school students are invited to a presentation to be held on Wednesday, January 10th beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Parish Activities Center. (Note: This is the meeting that was originally to have occurred in October but was rescheduled due to calendar conflicts.)

As this is such a very important topic related to the development of your child, we ask that at least one parent from each family new to the middle school be present at the meeting. Should you have any questions about this initiative, please do not hesitate to contact the office for more information.
