Principal's Message

Tomorrow each family will receive **Re-Registration Forms for the 2018-2019** academic year. Parents are asked to complete all of the forms and return them to the office no later than Friday, February 16th. Please note that forms submitted after this date will require a \$25.00 late fee.

Again this year, in addition to including the name of your parish on the form, we ask that you also provide your parish registration number. This will allow us to more efficiently verify parish registration as we confirm tuition plans for each family.

Registration of students *new* to All Saints, including *siblings* who will be eligible by age for Pre-Kindergarten, has already begun. Separate forms related to this initial registration process have been sent home to parents who have previously expressed interest in enrolling another child in our program. If you are interested in enrolling another child from your family and have not yet requested forms, please contact Mrs. Joyce D'Eugenio at 703-393-1490 or office@allsaintsva.org.

As we plan for the upcoming year, it is our goal to continue to provide the same commitment to excellence, the same level of service, and the same quality that you have come to associate with the All Saints' experience. At the same time, we want to continue to bolster salaries for our faculty and staff who are so dedicated to our mission and continue to advance our programs.

In order to sustain these commitments, tuition for grades K-8 will increase 3% for the 2018-2019 academic year. There will be no increase in the Pre-Kindergarten tuition rates.

The following is a schedule of the in-parish tuition rates for 2018-2019. The actual per student cost of education is included as a point of reference. We are grateful for the continued support of the diocese, the parish, PTO and individual donors who enable us to maintain a high degree of affordability for families in our community.

Thank you to those families who have confirmed their interest in the Pre-Kindergarten program for the upcoming year. We are continuing to closely track the demand for full day vs. half day classes. In the event that there is sufficient demand for a separate class of half day students, I have submitted a proposal to Fr. Roos and parish leadership for the proposed use of another space for a third classroom. If the demand is insufficient for a new classroom, it remains a possibility that those interested in the half day experience might be placed in the full day program with the option of being picked up mid-day. Similarly, we are closely tracking input from applicants regarding interest in before and after school care for Pre-Kindergarten students. Although this is a service that we have only previously offered for students in K-8, we are examining the feasibility of expanding the Extended Day program to include Pre-Kindergarten students. These decisions are dependent upon the actual return of applications, a process that has already begun and for which there is a deadline of February 23rd. I anticipate being able to make a final decision regarding the half day program and Extended Day services at that time. In the meantime, I thank you for your patience as we consider strategies aimed at meeting the needs of our current school families while adapting to the increased demand in the community for full day classes.
