#### Principal's Message

This week I am pleased to share with you an update regarding the design of our Pre-Kindergarten program for the 2018-2019 academic year.

As you are aware, in addition to offering two full day classes, we have also been exploring strategies in support of a half day option for those in our community who prefer this schedule.

After consideration of the space limitations and challenges related to the possibility of opening a new classroom, it has been determined that offering a separate half day class will not be feasible. However, in an effort to meet the needs of those families seeking the half day experience, we will implement a "blended" model in which a small group of students will depart each day at 11:15 a.m. By reserving five spots in each of our full day Pre-Kindergarten classes, we will be able to provide a half day option for all of our current families who have expressed a preference for this schedule and be able to accommodate several new applicants as well.

In light of the significant demand for after school care, we will be offering Extended Day services from 3:00-6:30 p.m. for Pre-Kindergarten students in the full day program. We will be limiting attendance to twenty students which will allow us to accommodate those who through the application process have already confirmed their interest in the program. As there is very small demand for before school care, Extended Day services will not be available for Pre-Kindergarten children prior to the start of the school day.

Further details regarding the Extended Day Program for Pre-Kindergarten students, including the fee structure, will be announced in the weeks ahead.

I wish to thank Mrs. Parriott (Director of Pre-Kindergarten), Ms. Reardon (Director of Extended Day), Mrs. DeVore (Director of Marketing and Development) and Mrs. D'Eugenio (Administrative Assistant) for their assistance in revising our programs to better meet the needs of families in our community.

We look forward to the year ahead and the expansion of our full day Pre-Kindergarten!

#### CRS Rice Bowl – Important Reminders

As we near the conclusion of Lent, we want to thank you for encouraging your children to participate in the Rice Bowl project. This initiative has provided our students a very specific way to embrace the practice of prayer, fasting and almsgiving during this liturgical season.
