In accordance with this act, this notification is being provided to you to inform you that asbestos-containing materials are present in our school. A copy of our school

Management Plan contains the exact locations of any asbestos-containing materials and is maintained on file in the archives. This plan, with documentation dating back to the 1980's, is available for your review and inspection during normal school hours. As such, please feel free to request information on or about our Management Plan and inspection findings.
