Title I Program Update

In order to qualify for the program, students must be residents of the City of Manassas or live within the jurisdiction of a Title I zoned school in Prince William County and meet specific academic criteria.

Mrs. Sue DeAngelis, a retired teacher from Manassas City Public Schools, will serve as our Title I teacher this year. Mrs. DeAngelis and the faculty are finishing the referral process for students who meet the program criteria.

As we focus on differentiation in all of our classrooms, Title I continues to be a highly effective program for us in that it specifically targets the learning needs of our students.
