Principal's Message

Through the generosity of donors and the commitment of our diocese and parish, in recent years All Saints has been able to provide significant tuition assistance for families in our community who meet the criteria for financial aid. One of the most significant streams of revenue for this effort has been generated through the *Diocesan Scholarship Foundation*.

We have received notification through the Virginia Catholic Conference that the continuation of the Education Improvement Scholarship Tax Credit, the program that funds the Diocesan Scholarship Foundation, is at risk.

In that the benefit to families in our community exceeds \$100,000 in financial aid, this is a significant concern. As such, I wish to invite you to become an advocate for this program by sharing testimonials, meeting with legislators, donating to the foundation and educating friends and colleagues about the program.
