



# Affording a Catholic Education

## Tuition Assistance Opportunities Available

Would you like to provide your child with the many benefits of a Catholic education but are concerned about the cost? Our parish school offers current and prospective students multiple sources for potential financial aid at both the parish and diocesan levels.

### Parish & School Financial Aid

All Saints Catholic Church and School maintains a robust commitment to tuition assistance to ensure Catholic education remains accessible. Funding is further enhanced through the following diocesan initiatives.

### Arlington Diocese Financial Aid (*K-8 qualified students*)

- Diocesan Tuition Grant Program - provides assistance to families attending Arlington Diocesan schools. It is open to all qualified students whose parents may not otherwise be able to afford full tuition. This program receives money annually from all parishes in the Arlington Diocese and from the *Rooted in Faith-Forward in Hope* endowment.
- St. Beatrice Special Tuition Assistance Program - provides assistance to single parents with children and families with children attending multiple diocesan schools.
- Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation Grant - provides funding from individuals and businesses who receive a 65% tax credit for their donation to the Scholarship Foundation. Families eligible for this program must have students in kindergarten or first grade, and must meet income criteria. First grade students must be transferring from either a public school or out of state. The amount awarded is limited by legislation but can be supplemented by other funding.

### Pre-Kindergarten Financial Aid

Families who are interested in applying for tuition assistance for All Saints' Pre-Kindergarten Program are asked to complete the FACTS assessment (*see right*). Although Pre-K students are not eligible for diocesan aid, the FACTS analysis will guide the process of determining assistance for parish and school funding.

### How To Apply for Financial Aid

Families requesting assistance must submit an application with the processing fee and supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. This independent company is contracted by the Diocese of Arlington to provide confidential and objective economic analyses to determine need. Applications are available through All Saints or you can apply online at <https://online.factsmgmt.com/signin/3Q327>.

### Application Deadlines

Applications/documentation for assistance must be received by FACTS (not just postmarked) by January 22, 2019 (if you also have a high school student) or March 15, 2019 for elementary/middle school students. Only complete applications with all documentation will be considered.
