Principal's Message

On Friday each family will receive **Re-Registration Forms for the 2019-2020** academic year. Parents are asked to complete all of the forms and return them to the office no later than Friday, February 1st. Please note that forms submitted after this date will require a \$25.00 late fee.

Registration of students *new* to All Saints, including *siblings* who will be eligible by age for Pre-Kindergarten, has already begun. Separate forms related to this initial registration process have been sent home to parents who have previously expressed interest in enrolling another child in our program.
