Principal's Message

As we prepare for the annual celebration of Catholic Schools Week, we are reminded of the many blessings surrounding our school community. All Saints is a place where the very best traditions of our Catholic faith are integrated in a dynamic learning environment each day. It is a place where students are challenged intellectually and encouraged to grow in virtue. Most importantly, it is a place where students encounter Christ through the Sacraments and interactions with faculty, staff and one another.

One of the hallmarks of our school continues to be the high degree of affordability for families in our community. With a strong commitment to tuition assistance, the gift of Catholic education has become a reality for many.

This initiative is balanced by our equally strong commitment to excellence. As we plan for the upcoming year, it is our goal to continue to provide the same level of service and the same quality that you have come to associate with our program.

In order to sustain these commitments, tuition for grades Pre-K-8 will increase 4% for the 2019-2020 academic year.

The following is a schedule of the tuition rates for 2019-2020. We are grateful for the continued support of the diocese, our parish, the PTO and individual donors who enable us to maintain this affordable fee structure.

In addition, there will be an increase in fees associated with the Extended Day Program that will better align our pricing structure with that offered by schools across our diocese. This change will communicate the value associated with the level of care provided while continuing to provide parents an affordable option for before and after school care. A detailed list of fees for the program may be found on the Extended Day registration form enclosed in the re-registration packet.

Finally, there will be a small increase in the Chromebook fees for students entering 6th grade. Beginning in the fall of 2019, the annual fee will increase by \$25.00. These additional funds will provide the financial basis for on-going repairs, maintenance and replacement costs. (Note: The fee increase will not impact those students entering 7th and 8th grade next year who are already enrolled in the Chromebook Program.)

After reviewing the re-registration forms that will be sent home this week, please do not hesitate to let us know should you have any questions. Although the date in the cover letter refers to a deadline of Friday, February 1st, due to the recent cancellations and the related delay in our process, the date has been extended to Wednesday, February 6th.
