### **Student Health Records and Immunization Requirements for 2019-2020**

Pre-School, Kindergarten and Newly enrolled students must have the Commonwealth of Virginia School Entrance Health Form filled out **completely prior to the first day of school**. These can be mailed or dropped off at the office as soon as you get them.

Part 1 is completed by the parent/guardian and Parts 2 & 3 are completed by the physician. Please see below for the form. All Medical Forms and Plans can be found on the All Saints Website under Parent Resources and the School Nurse page. Any student who has medication required for the school year will need to **complete the health plan and medication form annually**. The School Nurse will be available the week before and up to the first day of school for drop off of any medication. Thank you for following the Diocesan policies and making school entry a smooth process.

#### **Tuition Assistance Awards & FACTS Enrollment Process for 2019-2020**

The diocese is continuing to review applications for tuition assistance and to determine allocations from the St. Beatrice and Scholarship Foundation funds. For this reason, we anticipate that decisions regarding financial awards will not be confirmed and communicated to families for a couple more weeks.

In the meantime, all returning families who have not applied for tuition assistance should have already received a customized email from FACTS confirming their tuition balance

and payment plan for 2019-2020. All new families will receive a FACTS “invite” that will provide detailed directions for establishing an account.
