Principal's Message

This week I am pleased to share with you a change we will be trying in regards to our process for the scheduling of Parent-Teacher Conferences. In an effort to increase efficiency and to provide parents with the opportunity to select the day on which they wish to attend their meetings, we are implementing an electronic registration process. Within the next week, all families will receive an email with a link to an online form by which they may request specific times for their conferences.

All conferences will be allotted fifteen minutes, including those in the middle school. Of particular note, for grades 6-8, the first and second conference block of each hour (Example: 2:00-2:15 p.m. & 2:15-2:30 p.m.) will be reserved for meetings with House Advisors. The third and fourth blocks (Example: 2:30-2:45 p.m. & 2:45 – 3:00 p.m.) will be reserved for meetings by request of parents with specific subject teachers.

As a courtesy, the office staff will be contacting those families with four or more children enrolled so that we can schedule sequential conferences prior to opening the registration portal.

Again, look for a sign-up link for the conferences on November 11 & 12 in the days ahead.
