Principal's Message

At our most recent faculty meeting we spent some time discussing the expectations that we have for our students, specifically as related to the math program. In an effort to "raise the bar" and standardize our process, we are now implementing several procedures that we believe will encourage students to take greater pride in their work and to be even more thoughtful when completing math problems.

For example, the teachers are now providing their students with specific guidelines as to how they should complete the "header" on each of their pages, i.e. name, date, subject, etc. Even more importantly, the teachers are requiring that, when completing math problems, the students copy the example, show the work and place a box around the answer.

Admittedly, these are small adjustments related to the "mechanics" rather than the actual learning that is taking place. Nevertheless, this practice can foster routines of neatness and orderliness which can impact outcomes. In fact, we have seen that such procedures have yielded measurable gains on Scantron scores because the students have been encouraged to work very thoughtfully. In the words of one of our middle school students last week after using this new approach, "I can see my grade in math improving."

As you observe your children completing their math homework in the days ahead, offer them a few words of encouragement in this regard. Together we will be instilling habits of excellence, the benefits of which extend well beyond math.
