Principal's Message

This week I wish to provide an update regarding our efforts to increase our level of preparedness in response to concerns related to Coronavirus.During my meeting with the Crisis Management Team earlier this week, we focused on our communication plan and the goal of continuity of instruction for our students.In the event of a school closure, we recognize how important it will be to maintain open lines of communication and to be able to sustain educational services.

While we are still finalizing the details, I can share with you that it is our plan for teachers to leverage technology to share educational content with students in the event of a closure.With this in mind, we would like to confirm whether all families in our school community have Internet access and a computer within their home so that we can create any necessary contingency plans.

In support of this effort, today we are distributing a short survey to all families.Paper copies will be provided in both English and Spanish and sent home with the youngest child enrolled this afternoon. We ask that you complete the form and return it to your child's teacher no later than Friday, March 6.

I will continue to keep you apprised of our planning efforts. In the meantime, should you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me at any time.
