### Principal's Message

With cases of Coronavirus now positively confirmed in the metropolitan region, I wish to provide another update regarding our efforts to safeguard our students, faculty & staff and to plan for continuity of instruction in the event of a closure.

As this situation unfolds, I continue to be in consultation with the diocese as well as other experts within the community. Today I am participating in a webinar hosted by the Virginia Department of Health for private school leaders from across the state. These collaborations allow for the sharing of "best practice" and also provide reference points as to how school communities are responding to the crisis.

Here are three important steps that parents can take at this time to help ensure the health of our school community:

- Adherence to Illness Policy In accordance with the Parent-Student Handbook, children with fevers, contagious, or infectious diseases will be sent home promptly and excluded from school while in that condition, per Virginia Department of Health regulations. Once the student is confirmed to be free of communicable illness by a healthcare provider or is fever free/symptom free for 24 hours without taking anti-fever medications, the student may return to school, afterschool, and extracurricular activities.
- Communicating Concerns Regarding Potential Exposure
   In the event that you believe that you or a member of your family may have been in contact
   with an individual positively diagnosed with Coronavirus or are exhibiting symptoms, please
   contact our school nurse, Mrs. Snowden.It will be important for us to partner with you to ensure
   the implementation of proper protocols in accordance with the Virginia Department of Health
   and the Office of Catholic Schools.
- Communicating Travel Plans
   We are asking parents/guardians, faculty, and staff to please notify our school of any travel plans in an effort to keep our community healthy. The countries of concern change daily and allowing us to know your plans will help us to work with you upon your return.

Mrs. Snowden, our school nurse, serves as the point of contact. We invite you to share any travel related information regarding members of your family or visitors via the following email address: clinic@allsaintsva.org.

Concerns related to Coronavirus can result in an increase in stress and anxiety for our students as they grapple with the uncertainly of the situation. With this in mind, Mrs. Slater (school counselor) and Mrs. Snowden (school nurse) are preparing a message for parents that will include helpful resources for discussing this topic with children. Look for this special message in the days ahead.

By the close of this week I will forward to you a summary of our plan for continuity of instruction. In addition to informing you of our procedures, this advance communication will provide you the opportunity to ask questions and share any challenges you foresee prior to any potential closure.

I will continue to keep you apprised of our planning efforts in the days ahead. In the meantime, should you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me at any time.
