# Principal's Message

Yesterday afternoon I was pleased to share with you a letter from our Superintendent, Dr. Vorbach, providing updates regarding summer programs and the year ahead. Additionally, this week the Office of Catholic Schools distributed an electronic survey to parents across the diocese requesting feedback on the transition to eLearning and also seeking input relative to planning for the upcoming year. I wish to thank those parents in our school community who were able to take a few minutes to respond and participate in this process.

The feedback that parents provide, particularly during a time of transition and innovation, is vitally important to the success of our mission. Through my own conversations with parents over the course of the past several weeks, I have been reminded of the great work to which we have all been committed and the extraordinary dedication shown by faculty, staff, parents and students.

With that said, we collectively recognize that our launch into distance learning was not a course that we deliberately chose after extensive research and reflection. Instead, it was an "emergency response" during a moment in which the collective efforts of many ensured that our families remained connected and that our students continued learning. There have been lessons learned along the way and we realize that this effort represents a building block upon which future efforts may be constructed.

As we continue to plan for a number of scenarios for the upcoming year, it is important that I share with you that any future eLearning will look different from what we have experienced this spring. For example, rather than focusing on teaching the "essentials," our aim will be to effectively deliver the entire curriculum. To accomplish this task, we will need to provide an even higher level of student engagement and direct instruction facilitated by the teachers. In support of this objective and as announced in Dr. Vorbach's letter, the Office of Catholic Schools is investing in professional development for our faculty during the summer that will enhance teacher readiness for hybrid delivery of the curriculum if necessary.

Last week I shared with you that we are taking steps to plan, prepare and position

ourselves for a variety of outcomes as we look to the future. With this in mind, I am launching a Continuity of Mission Task Force that will participate in the development of plans, the execution of key tasks and the future evaluation of effectiveness. My hope is that the work of this group will result in a well-defined process for moving forward and an ability to adapt our procedures and delivery of educational services as conditions require.

At this point I recognize that there are understandably more questions than answers. As future guidance is provided by the State of Virginia, our local officials and the Office of Catholic Schools, we will be able to define and communicate our plans for a variety of paths forward. I will continue to keep you updated as information is received and decisions are made. In the meantime, know of our continued commitment and resolve to ensuring that the mission of All Saints remains strong and promising during a time of uncertainty and change.

However, the prekindergarten teachers will continue to provide informal updates regarding the progress of each child in the program as they prepare for the transition to kindergarten.

Note: This change does not impact the plan for students in grades K-8. Report cards, including grades for the third trimester, will be issued for these students at the close of the year.
