Principal's Message

On behalf of our Pastor, Fr. Lee Roos, our clergy, faculty, and staff, I wish to extend our heartfelt congratulations to all of our 8th grade students who will soon graduate from All Saints Catholic School. We recognize how hard they have worked through the years and applaud their perseverance during the transition to eLearning.

Although our plans have been significantly impacted due to the pandemic and school closure, we remain committed to making this a very special moment for our 8th grade students. The following is a summary of events and activities that will occur over the course of the next several weeks.

Graduation Day (Friday, June 5)

• Virtual Pass It On Ceremony

During this virtual prayer service, a representative of the Graduating Class of 2020 will pass the mantle of leadership to his sister, a representative of the current 7th grade class, symbolized through the handing on of 8th Grade Medals. A link to the pre-recorded prayer service will be forwarded to the school community at 9:30 a.m.

• Virtual 8th Grade Walk of Honor

Since the graduates are unable to participate in this tradition, Mrs. Honkus and Mrs. DeBruyne will walk in their honor. A link to the pre-recorded event that will include a recognition of each 8th grade student will be forwarded to the school community at 11:00 a.m.

• Final Day Closeout ~ Drop-Off & Pick-Up of Materials

All 8th grade students are invited to drop-off and pick-up materials from 1:00-3:00 p.m. Families are asked to enter the property via the rear parking lot and to follow the traffic pattern used for morning arrival. All parents and students are asked to remain in their vehicles at all times. Members of the faculty and staff will be present and will deliver to each vehicle any personal items from the classroom and/or lockers. Students are asked to place all of their books and school items in a bag, keeping separate any library books that they need to return.

Graduation Mass (Thursday, June 25)

Since our parish is now permitted to offer limited public Masses, we are pleased to announce that a Graduation Mass will take place in the church at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 25.

Due to the need for social distancing measures and related precautions, the event will be open only to graduates and their immediate family members. The ceremony will be modified to ensure the health and safety of those gathered and in accordance with the guidance provided by our diocese and implemented by our parish. Due to the continued requirement for social distancing, we will not be hosting a reception following the event.

However, there are a couple of special surprises that the faculty and staff have been preparing for our graduates. We hope that these efforts and the events we are planning will convey to our students how very proud we are of each of them.

Participation in this program will enhance our capacity to provide high quality instruction and assess learning in both the traditional classroom setting as well as that of eLearning.

Schoology is a highly engaging platform for students, teachers, and administrators that integrates all aspects of the teaching and learning process. With a user-friendly design, the software application is a robust tool that provides many opportunities for collaboration and community-building.

A learning management system that has been in existence for ten years, Schoology is now owned by PowerSchool which allows for easy synchronization of data. Schoology also integrates seamlessly with our productivity tools, specifically Google and Microsoft Office, as well as more than 200 educational applications and content providers, including Khan Academy, Kahoot, Youtube, and Quizlet.

With teachers having the ability to transition classroom methodologies to an online environment, Schoology will allow us to be very nimble as we plan for a variety of scenarios for the 2020-2021 academic year.
