# All Saints Catholic School Reopening Parent Survey-July 2020 

Below are results of the Reopening of School Parent Survey conducted in July 2020. The purpose of the survey was to gain a broader understanding of the needs and preferences of ourschool community regarding the reopening of All Saints Catholic Schoolfor the 2020-2021 school year.

## Question 1

Although we anticipate at this time that students will return to the building for some in-person instruction as we begin the year, it is likely that social distancing restrictions will remain in effect. Given the understanding that any variance from the 6-foot physical distancing guideline would require greater compliance with other health mitigation strategies, such as the wearing of masks, please indicate your preference. (183Answered)

## Responses:

- Yes, I would prefer that the school implement a variance to allow for less than 6-foot physical distancing with an increased requirement for the wearing of mask.

## Question 2

Assuming that some in-person instruction will occur for students in grades $K-8$, please indicate your preference at this time regarding your child's participation. (190Answered)

## Responses:

- Yes, I am planning to send my child/ren to school for in-person instruction.
81.05\% - 154 Responses
- No, I am not planning to send my child/ren to school for in-person instruction and would prefer that he/she participate in eLearning.
9.47\% - 18 Responses


## Question 3

Mindful of the priority of having our students participate in on-site learning to the greatest extent possible and the importance of aligning our plans with parent schedules, please indicate your preference in the event that in-person instruction occurs less than five days perweek. (185 Answered)

- Option \#1 - Two student groups within each grade level that attend either Monday/Wednesday/ Friday or Tuesday / Thursday with a rotation between the assigned days each week. For example, half of $3 A$ attends $M / W / F$ the first week while the other half of $3 A$ attends $T / T h$. The following week, the groups flip their days and half of $3 A$ attends $T / T h$ while the other half of $3 A$ attends $M / W / F$.
- Option \#2 - Two student groups within each grade level that attend either Monday / Wednesday or Tuesday / Thursday as well as Friday every other week. For example, half of $3 A$ attends $M / W$ and the other half of $3 A$ attends Tuesday/Thursday each week. During week 1, half of $3 A$ also attends inperson instruction on Friday; the following week, they flip and the other half of $3 A$ attends in-person instruction on Friday.
