Principal's Message

As we complete our third week of school, I again wish to recognize and thank the faculty and staff for their outstanding work. Attendance

On eLearning Fridays, parents are asked to notify the school office if their child will not be in attendance. Since students participate in asynchronous learning on Fridays, i.e. working independently and at their own pace, parent notification on those days will be the primary means by which we track attendance.

The teachers will monitor student engagement, but it remains possible that a particular student may be on a break when the teacher is reviewing student progress or completion of work. For this reason, please notify us if your child will be absent for the day.

Zoom Classes & Parent Involvement

Thank you for the support that you continue to provide to your children in helping them adapt to the virtual learning environment. We recognize that it has required a degree of oversight and technical assistance, without which your son/daughter would not be able to participate in the daily learning.

In an effort to foster resiliency and good work habits in our students, we encourage you to allow your child to complete all of their virtual learning activities independently. To the extent possible, we want each student's virtual learning experience to mirror that which is taking place in the classroom. Allowing your child to work through challenges with the assistance of the teacher and his/her classmates will provide important learning opportunities and promote a growth mindset.

Stewardship Shares - Update for 2020-2021

For many years, the Stewardship Shares program has been the mechanism by which parents have earned and tracked their required volunteer hours. We know that educational research indicates that students excel in school when their parents are highly involved and have been pleased to maintain a strong partnership with you in this regard through the years.

Due to the decrease in volunteer opportunities because of the cancellation or postponement of activities and in light of the restrictions now in place that limit volunteers in the building, this year parents are encouraged to complete only 10 Stewardship Shares rather than fulfilling the 25 required Shares as in prior years.

Cafeteria Program – Account Balances Update

Many of our school families currently have a positive balance on their lunch accounts from 2019-2020 and we have initiated a process to provide refunds accordingly.

For families with significant balances (greater than \$10.00), the school will automatically initiate a refund to their FACTS tuition account unless the parent indicates that they prefer that the school retain the balance as a donation.
