#### Principal's Message

As a follow up to Governor Northam's announcement of last Friday and the guidance provided by Dr. Vorbach, Superintendent of Schools, this week I wish to provide a couple of updates.

Since the gathering size reduction from 250 to 25 persons does not apply to educational settings, public or private, there is no change to our schedule or program at this time. Similarly, since all of our students have already been wearing masks, we are fully compliant with the new mandate that all persons over the age of five wear masks in schools.

Nevertheless, as this is a time for increased diligence, mask breaks will now be limited to times when students are eating/drinking or when they are outside and maintaining six-foot social distancing. There may be moments when a teacher may grant a rare exception due to specific circumstances, but wearing of masks throughout the day will be the norm.

Beginning this week, Mrs. Horgan will be sending a newsletter entitled **Assistant Principal's Corner** to parents every two weeks highlighting aspects of our curriculum and how we are integrating technology in the learning process. We hope that this additional communication will provide you even more insights regarding the wonderful things that are taking place at All Saints each day. Look for the first edition of Mrs. Horgan's letter in your inbox tomorrow.

As the first trimester draws to a close, the faculty have had an opportunity to reflect upon our current practice and "lessons learned" during the first part of the school year. It has come to our attention that there have been a greater number of instances of cheating among students as they complete their online learning. In many cases, this has involved students researching answers online while completing assessments. This occurrence is a reminder that some of the structures and procedures surrounding the learning process have changed due to the pandemic and our school schedule. Accordingly, it is important that we recognize this as a learning moment for our students, one in which we can address how honesty and integrity are an essential part of the pursuit of academic excellence and our call to holiness. For this reason, Mrs. Horgan and the teachers in grades 5-8 will introduce a new **Honor Code** to the students during an assembly via Zoom beginning at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, December 1. It is our hope that the information and procedures that will be provided will inspire our students to higher levels of personal responsibility and foster their character formation.
