FACTS Enrollment & Tuition Assistance Update

As we make plans for the upcoming year, one of our priorities is that of continuing to provide as much tuition assistance as possible for families in our community. Through the generous and on-going support of our parish and the diocese, we have been able to provide financial aid totaling more than \$250,000 for the 2020-2021 academic year.

In an effort to secure as much financial support as possible for our community, we have submitted applications on behalf of our school families for funding through the *Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation* and the *St. Beatrice Special Tuition Assistance Program.*

Diocesan allocations related to all of these sources of tuition assistance will be confirmed in the weeks ahead. Once we receive this information, we will be able to make final decisions regarding tuition assistance for those families who have applied.

Notification of tuition assistance funding for those who have applied will take place by early June. The FACTS re-enrollment process for 2021-2022 and selection of online tuition payment plans will occur during May with June 11 being the deadline for payment in full with a 2% discount.
