# **Principal's Message**

During the summer months our school applied for additional COVID-19 relief funding through **Emergency Assistance to Non-Public Schools (EANS)**. I am pleased to share with you that through this program All Saints is receiving funding in support of our continued mitigation strategies as well as instructional initiatives designed to close learning gaps.

Through EANS, in addition to purchasing supplies to sanitize and disinfect the facility, we have acquired new furniture for the pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, and library to allow for physical distancing as well as a limited number of standing desks for student use in various classrooms. We have also purchased iPads to be used in support of differentiation of learning in the primary grades. Perhaps most significantly, we have been granted approval for a two-year contract by which an additional teacher will be assigned to All Saints for the specific purpose of providing small group instruction to assist students struggling in math.

We are hopeful that our participation in EANS will not only give us the important resources that we need to continue to maintain a safe environment, but will also allow us to respond to some of the educational impact that has occurred as a result of the pandemic.

I look forward to providing you updates as details are confirmed and we begin to implement new programs and resources.

I wish to thank those parents who have already signed up to attend a **Parent-Teacher Conference**. Those who have not yet done so are asked to complete this process no later than Friday. Should you have any questions or experience difficulty with the online registration, please do not hesitate to let us know. On Monday, November1 we will celebrate our patronal feast, **All Saints Day**. The school will attend the 8:30 a.m. parish Mass after which the 8 grade students will present the lives of the saints in the Parish Activity Center. All of our students, faculty, and staff will enjoy free ice cream during lunch, courtesy of the PTO on the occasion of our feast day!
