Message from the Nurse – Travel Guidance & Recommendations

I hope you have been enjoying the fall weather and the pumpkin spice and everything nice that comes along with it! The holidays are approaching and we all look forward to celebrating our family traditions together.

The safest way to minimize the risk of COVID-19 is following these CDC recommendations:

- Unvaccinated people should wear a well-fitting mask in public indoor areas.
- Even those who are fully vaccinated should wear a mask in public indoor settings in communities with substantial to high transmission. Outdoors is safer than indoors.
- Avoid crowded, poorly ventilated spaces.
- If you are sick or have symptoms, don't host or attend a gathering.
- Get <u>tested</u> if you have symptoms of COVID-19 or have a close contact with someone who has COVID-19.

We encourage everyone to follow the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommendations for domestic and international travel.
