Principal's Message

I hope that you and your family enjoyed the weeklong Thanksgiving holiday. I am pleased to share with you that our students contributed more than 2,000 pounds of food through our annual Thanksgiving food drive. It was a great joy to see the students presenting their gifts of food during our school Mass on November 19. Thank you to all of our students for their great generosity and to the National Junior Honor Society for leading this initiative.

Through the years at All Saints we have established several traditions that help to create a tone of anticipation and waiting as we prepare our hearts to celebrate the coming of our Savior at Christmas. Through prayer and outreach to the local community, our students will once again have an opportunity to enter more fully into this season of hope.

Advent Wreath Prayer Services

On Monday morning the students assembled in the Parish Activities Center at 8:30 a.m. for a school-wide prayer service highlighting the meaning of the Advent Wreath. During the second and third weeks of Advent, each Monday morning students will gather around three separate wreaths in each of the hallways of the school where they will participate in grade level prayer services.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

Each of the students in grades three through eight will have an opportunity to encounter Christ in this beautiful Sacrament of healing and forgiveness during two Penance Services. The Advent Penance Service for grades 3-5 occurred on Monday with one to follow for grades 6-8 on Monday, December 6.

"Spirit of Christmas" Food Drive

Our students can help to make a difference in the lives of those less fortunate by donating to the Bethany Food Pantry during this Advent season. Members of the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) will conduct a food drive from December 1 - December 15 to benefit the less fortunate in our

community. The food pantry is in need of the following items: maseca, sugar, oil, salt, canned chicken, meal helpers, flavored rice, pancake mix, syrup, and oatmeal. Items may be dropped off in the breezeway during morning arrival after which members of the NJHS will deliver the items to the food pantry.

“Christmas Joy” Toy Drive

Families may also choose to donate new unwrapped toys and to bring a smile to a child this Advent season. The NJHS will sponsor a toy drive to benefit the children of the Saint Gabriel Mission between December 1 - December 15. Toys may be dropped off in the breezeway during arrival. Members of the NJHS will arrange for delivery to the Saint Gabriel Mission.
