Principal's Message

Due to the recent schedule changes related to inclement weather and COVID-19 cases in our community, we are delaying the administration of Scantron *Performance Series* testing by one week. The diocese has extended the testing window until February 4, providing us the time necessary for our students to complete the second round of this standardized testing program.

Earlier in the year we distributed copies of individual results for students in grades 3-7 who completed the first round of testing in September. This week I am pleased to share with you a grade level summary of scores in the three areas of reading, math, and language arts.

Each of these scores represents the grade level national percentile ranking which indicates how the students as a whole performed when compared to the national norm group at the same level. For example, an NPR of 71 would mean that the student group scored above 71% of their grade-level peers in the national norm group.

Scantron Scores

All of our grade level scores are well above the national average which is represented by 50 percentile, a success story for our students and teachers. Given the challenges that we have navigated over the course of the past year related to the pandemic and the corresponding fluctuation in enrollment, we can be pleased with the strong start to this academic year that is indicated by these scores.

Although the Scantron results should be viewed as one snapshot of each child's academic progress, the results provide important data for instructional planning. For example, one area for continued focus is that of math. Related to this, earlier in the year I announced that our school had applied for funding through the Emergency Assistance to Non-Public Schools (EANS) program. As part of this initiative, I am pleased to share with you that Mrs. Maya Miernik has been hired to work as a math remediation specialist. Through her small group instruction of students who are struggling in their understanding of math, we are hoping to further close existing learning gaps.

Mrs. Miernick earned a Masters of Elementary Education from Rutgers University and has extensive experience teaching a broad range of subjects in Manassas Park Public Schools. Additionally, she has worked in the field of English as a Second Language (ESOL) and has a strong working knowledge of Spanish. We welcome Mrs. Miernik to our school as she prepares to begin working with students next week.

The teachers are already in the process of identifying students who will benefit from this small group instruction. Mrs. Horgan is coordinating the details for the launch of this new program and will be forwarding letters and parent approval forms to those whose children have been selected to participate.
