## Principal's Message

With the weather turning colder and the winter season just around the corner, I want to take a moment this week to provide important updates regarding our **Inclement Weather Policy**. For a number of years, All Saints Catholic School has followed the decision of Prince William County Public Schools regarding schedule changes due to weather conditions. However, with the recent announcement that the county is implementing new inclement weather procedures, it has been determined that All Saints will now make an independent decision regarding schedule changes for the school beginning today.

Per diocesan policy, if school closes unexpectedly for a single day, there will be no academic requirements for that day. If, however, the school will be closed for an extended period due to weather or public health concern, the school will transition to online (eLearning) for the required duration and students will meet academic requirements. On these eLearning days it will be our goal to ensure a full day of student engagement and learning. I am working with the faculty on the design of a schedule for synchronous learning, i.e. class-wide instruction via Zoom, and look forward to sharing these details in the near future.

As in the past, all decisions regarding schedule changes will be announced to the community via SchoolMessenger and posted on our school website.

Thank you to the many families who supported our recent "We Care Week" Dress Down Day to benefit Catholic Charities. I am pleased to report that we collected a total of \$580.14. All of these funds will be directed toward the St. Lucy Project which provides food donations to our local Manassas community.

Last Friday a number of families gathered for an *Evening with St. Nicholas*, an Advent prayer service followed by a reception in the Parish Activities Center. Through music, readings and prayer, the children had an opportunity to learn more about the life and legacy of St. Nicholas, culminating in their presentation of 67 pairs of shoes at the foot of the altar. All of the shoes collected during the event have been donated to House of Mercy to benefit the needy in our community. Thank you to those who participated in this event and who through their generosity have helped to brighten the lives of those less fortunate. If you weren't able to attend the event but would still like to donate a pair of shoes, there is a box located near the front office. Donations will be accepted through Friday, December 10th.

Thank you, Mrs. Roccograndi, for once again organizing this beautiful event for our school community. I also wish to thank the members of the Schola who led the music under the direction of Miss McPhilamy as well as the volunteer students and parents who assisted with the many details behind the scenes. Festive and prayerful, it was an event that captured the spirit of Advent.
