Principal's Message

Congratulations to our 2nd grade students who received their First Reconciliation on Saturday. We are so very proud of them and we thank Miss Walker and Mrs. Lasseter for so thoughtfully preparing the children to encounter Christ in this beautiful Sacrament for the first time.

During the past month, students in grades 3-7 completed the second round of Scantron testing. On Friday the homeroom teachers in these grade levels will send home copies of individual student scores to parents.

Last week we learned that Scantron has made the decision to discontinue the sale and support of the *Performance Series* testing platform in order to focus on their core business of scanners and forms, a solution that serves K-12 students across the nation in support of assessment. With this news, the Office of Catholic Schools has initiated a process for identifying a new testing vendor and will be engaging the diocesan assessment committee and other stakeholders in this decision-making process.

For now, please know that standardized testing through Scantron will continue through May. The teachers will continue using the data from the first two rounds to inform their instructional planning for the remaining months of the school year.

I look forward to sharing additional information with you regarding the future of standardized testing at All Saints as those details become available.

With submission of this contract, there will be no need for future completion of an annual re-registration form.

CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT CONTRACT

After signing the contract, the Continuous Enrollment Fee, formerly known as the Re-Registration Fee, will automatically be billed to your FACTS account on March 1, 2022. The completion of the Contract and payment of Fee confirms enrollment for your child/ren for the upcoming school year.

Please note that failure to complete the Continuous Enrollment Contract by the deadline of February 25 may result in a space not being reserved for your child for the upcoming school year.
