#### **Principal's Message**

This week I would like to provide an update regarding the *Design for Excellence* reaccreditation project. We are currently working on the final revisions of our self-study document and organizing all of the evidence that the teacher committees have submitted in support of the accreditation standards and benchmarks.

I want to thank the faculty and staff for working so diligently on this project during a year already marked by challenges related to the pandemic. Each teacher has served as the member of a committee that has been responsible for responding to a specific series of questions related to one of four domains. Through this consensus-building process, the teachers have had an opportunity to thoughtfully reflect on all aspects of our school and are now identifying goals for future growth and improvement.

I would also like to thank you for your participation in the DFE Parent Survey which we administered during the fall semester. Approximately 53% of the parent community responded to the survey.

#### DFE SURVEY RESULTS

As part of the survey, numerous parents provided substantive feedback via the narrative response questions. While the positive responses were very affirming of the overall experience of All Saints, the constructive feedback has helped the faculty gain insights as to how we can increase effectiveness and the level of parent satisfaction as we plan for the future. Working in their instructional teams, the faculty are now determining their recommendations for action steps that we can implement in response to this data. I look forward to sharing more details regarding these efforts in the future. Again, thank you for participating in this very important process.

Occurring only every six years, the self-study is a major undertaking that requires a significant commitment on the part of the faculty and staff. I remain grateful for their steadfastness and dedication in completing this project which is essential, not only for reaccreditation, but for outlining a plan for the future of our school.

We look forward to the arrival of the seven member DFE Visiting Team on Tuesday, April 26. In addition to sharing with them the evidence that we have compiled in support of the benchmarks, it will be an opportunity for us to showcase the distinct mission of All Saints Catholic School.

On another topic, recently I have received several questions regarding the mask policy for faculty and staff. At this time, the Department of Labor and Industry (DOLI) Standard will remain in effect for at least another month, meaning that as long as community transmission rates are substantial or high according to the Virginia Department of Health (VDH), all employees must still mask while indoors. The Virginia Safety and Health Code recommended a revocation of this standard last week and a process has begun by which this policy will be further reviewed. As this process will require at least thirty days, our faculty and staff will continue to wear masks at this time while inside the building. In accordance with our Reopening Plan, visitors and volunteers are also required to continue to wear masks while in the school. In the event of any changes to these policies, I will provide updates via email. In the meantime, should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to let me know.

#### Continuous Enrollment Program – Due Friday!

Parents are reminded to sign and return the Continuous Enrollment Contract by <u>February</u> <u>25.</u> Through completion of this form, you will continuously enroll your child/ren through 8<sup>th</sup> grade from All Saints or, if necessary, until such time that you complete the withdrawal process. With submission of this contract, there will be no need for future completion of an annual re-registration form.

#### CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT CONTRACT

After signing the contract, the Continuous Enrollment Fee, formerly known as the Re-Registration Fee, will automatically be billed to your FACTS account on March 1, 2022. The completion of the Contract and payment of Fee confirms enrollment for your child/ren for the upcoming school year.

Please note that failure to complete the Continuous Enrollment Contract by the deadline of February 25 may result in a space not being reserved for your child for the upcoming school year.
