Sign Up

Once you have the access code, download the Schoology app from <u>Google Play</u> or the <u>Amazon</u> <u>App Store</u> and follow these steps to get started:

- 1. Open the app on your device and tap <u>Sign up for Schoology</u> at the bottom of the screen.
- 2. Tap **Student**.
- 3. Enter the 10-digit access code from your teacher.
- 4. Enter the following information for your profile:



Log-In Through Your School

Since many Enterprise schools have set up a custom login process, begin by selecting your school:

- 1. Use the keyboard to enter the name of your school or organization. As you type, matching choices populate in the list. The name, ID number, city, state, and zip code for the school should appear below.
- 2. Tap the name of your school or organization when it displays.
- 3. You can use an email address or username to log in to the application, depending on how your account was set up.
- 4. Tap **LOG IN** to complete.
