Principal's Message

During the 2021-2022 academic year, All Saints participated in the *Design for Excellence* (DFE) reaccreditation process. After our faculty completed a comprehensive self-study project beginning last fall, a team of educators visited our school during the final week of April. Following their three days of classroom visitations and interviews of faculty, staff, and parents, the team offered their recommendation for continued full accreditation for All Saints. As part of this process, the team also affirmed the strengths of our program and provided recommendations for continued future improvement.

As we begin the new school year, we have already started the process of creating a five-year plan that will incorporate the goals that we identified as part of the self-study project as well as specific reaccreditation benchmarks that we wish to strengthen prior to the next DFE visit in 2028.

We are on track to finalize the five-year plan by November 1, the time at which a copy of the document must be submitted to the Office of Catholic Schools of the Diocese of Arlington. As we complete this project, I look forward to sharing with you not only our goals for the next five years, but also our top priorities as part of this continuous improvement process.

DFE REPORT

This week I would also like to take an opportunity to provide a few reminders regarding our arrival and dismissal procedures.

Morning Arrival – During morning arrival, parents are asked to refrain from dropping off their children prior to 7:40 a.m., the time at which the staff begin their supervision of students as they enter the school. Any students dropped off prior to 7:40 a.m., with the exception of Safety Patrols on morning duty, must be signed-in at Extended Day in Father Kelley Hall. Additionally, all parents/guardians are asked to participate in the arrival system, remaining in their vehicles unless entering the school to drop-off items.

Afternoon Dismissal – The access gate to the rear parking lot will be opened at 2:35 p.m. each afternoon. Parents arriving prior to this time are asked to form a <u>single line</u> in the driveway adjacent to the Knights of Columbus and along the right side of Stonewall Road approaching the school property. Having only a single line in the driveway will allow for first responders to access the site in the event of an emergency.

During dismissal all parents are asked to display their carpool number in the windshield of their vehicles until they have picked up their children. Having the number clearly visible is helpful to the faculty and staff in identifying carpools as parents approach the loading area.

During both morning arrival and afternoon dismissal, we ask that parents refrain from turning left when entering and exiting the property during times of heavy traffic. This is very important so as not to cause delays on Stonewall Road and at the intersection with Route 28. This will also help to foster positive public relations with our neighbors and community partners.

In advance, thank you for your support of our efforts to ensure a safe and courteous arrival and dismissal process for our students, staff, and parents.

Student In-Service ~ Sexual Harassment, Our Policy & Response (Grades 6-8)

In accordance with diocesan policy, students in grades six through eight will participate in a brief classroom presentation within the next three weeks on the topic of the prevention of sexual harassment. Again this year, in consideration of the sensitivity of the topic, the training will be offered in a single-sex environment with Mr. Conroy addressing the boys while Miss Mallon will present to the girls. Each of the grade-level lessons will be approximately fifteen minutes in length and include an overview of the diocesan policy as well as an explanation as to how students should respond if they encounter any behaviors of this nature. Background Checks - Policies for School Parent Volunteers

As part of the diocesan initiative to maintain a safe environment for all of our children, all volunteers in the school are required to complete a background check prior to working in the school and to complete VIRTUS training within 45 days of submitting the background check application.

In accordance with diocesan policy, full compliance for an adult parent volunteer is not required for *open* events. (An open event is one that is open to the public, infrequent and publicized, such as Field Day, concerts and special events/assemblies.) However, full compliance is required for adult parent volunteers who wish to participate in closed events. (A closed event is one that is not entirely open to the general public such as classroom activities, parties, field trips, etc.) For this reason, all parents who wish to attend field trips or volunteer in support of classroom activities are required to complete the background check process and attend VIRTUS training.
