Principal's Message

I hope that you and your family enjoyed the Thanksgiving holiday. I am pleased to share with you that our students contributed 2,506 pounds of food through our annual Thanksgiving food drive. I want to thank all of our students for their great generosity and Mrs. Bill and the students of the National Junior Honor Society for leading the effort and organizing all of the food items following the prayer service last Tuesday.

Thanks to the very generous response of families in our community who participated in the Thanksgiving Luncheon, we received \$2,360 to benefit the St. Lucy Project as part of *Catholic Charities "We Care Week."* Thank you for your continued kindness and support of this important ministry that benefits the poor in the Manassas region.

Through the years at All Saints we have established several Advent traditions that help to create a tone of anticipation and waiting as we prepare our hearts to celebrate the coming of our Savior at Christmas. Through prayer and outreach to the local community, our students will once again have an opportunity to enter more fully into this season of hope.

Advent Wreath Prayer Services

On Monday morning the students assembled in the Parish Activities Center at 8:30 a.m. for a schoolwide prayer service highlighting the meaning of the Advent Wreath. During the remaining weeks of Advent, each Monday morning students will gather around three separate wreaths in each of the hallways of the school where they will participate in grade level prayer services.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

Each of the students in grades three through eight will have an opportunity to encounter Christ in this beautiful Sacrament of healing and forgiveness during two Penance Services. The Advent Penance Service for grades 3-5 occurred today with one to follow for grades 6-8 on Monday, December 5.

"Christmas Joy" Toy Drive

Families may choose to donate new unwrapped toys and to bring "Christmas Joy" to a child this Advent season. The NJHS will sponsor a toy drive to benefit the children of the Saint Gabriel Mission between December 5 – December 16. Toys may be dropped off in the breezeway entrance during morning arrival. Members of the NJHS will arrange for delivery to the Saint Gabriel Mission.

Christmas Treat Goodie Bags for St. Gabriel Mission

To coincide with the "Christmas Joy" Toy Drive, middle school students will participate in a service project in their respective Houses to prepare goodie bags filled with special treats to distribute to the children of Saint Gabriel. This week I am also pleased to announce that Dr. Christopher Gross will be joining our faculty to teach 6 grade religion beginning tomorrow. We look forward to Dr. Gross joining our faculty as the newest member of our middle school team.

New Student Applications & Continuous Enrollment for 2023-2024

Applications for new students for academic year 2023-2024 are now available online.

All current families who wish to enroll a *new student* in grades Pre-Kindergarten through eight for the upcoming year may access the application at the link below.

2023-2024 APPLICATION

In January we will provide a copy of the Continuous Enrollment Contract to parents of students completing their first year of enrollment at All Saints. Through completion of this form, parents may continuously enroll their child/ren through 8th grade from All Saints or, if necessary, until such time that they complete the withdrawal process. With submission of this contract, there is no need for future completion of an annual re-registration form.

The Continuous Enrollment Fee, formerly known as the Re-Registration Fee, will automatically be billed through FACTS accounts on February 1, 2023. The completion of the contract and payment of the fee will confirm enrollment for your child/ren for the upcoming school year.
