New Student Applications & Continuous Enrollment for 2023-2024

During January we will provide a copy of the *Continuous Enrollment Contract* to parents of students completing their first year of enrollment at All Saints. Through completion of this form, parents may continuously enroll their child/ren through 8th grade from All Saints or, if necessary, until such time that they complete the withdrawal process. With submission of this contract, there is no need for future completion of an annual re-registration form.

<u>The Continuous Enrollment Fee, formerly known as the Re-Registration Fee, will automatically be billed</u> <u>through FACTS accounts on **March 1, 2023**</u>. Note: This is a change from the originally announced date of February 1. The completion of the contract and payment of the fee will confirm enrollment for your child/ren for the upcoming school year.
