Message from our School Nurse

We have been seeing a lot of Norovirus and Strep A in the past couple of weeks, across multiple classes. Varying combinations of symptoms have included fever, headache, sore throat, stomachache, and vomiting. If a student is found to have fever, vomiting, or diarrhea, they will be sent home, and may return 24 hours after symptoms cease, without the use of medication.

We ask that if your child is sent home with fever and sore throat, you have them seen by a medical professional to determine diagnosis. We are committed to keeping all of our students safe and healthy so that they may remain at school and ask that you assist us in this endeavor by being vigilant and keeping sick students at home.

Per Diocesan policy: Children with fevers, contagious, or infectious diseases will be sent home promptly and excluded from school while in that condition, per Virginia Department of Health regulations. Once the student is confirmed to be free of communicable illness by a healthcare provider or is fever free/symptom free for 24 hours without taking anti-fever medications, the student may return to school.
