### National Drug Take Back Day

This Saturday, April 22nd is National Drug take Back Day, where you are able to safely dispose of medications no longer in use. This free, "no questions asked" opportunity is conducted twice yearly. It has proven to be a safe way to rid home medicine chests of unused prescription drugs often linked to misuse. Managed by Virginia State Police, drop-off sites accept tablets, capsules, patches and other solid forms of medication. Once batteries are removed, the sites also accept vape pens and other ecigarette devices. Sharps, illegal drugs, liquids including intravenous solutions and syringes cannot be accepted. All drugs brought to these locations are disposed of in a secure, environmentally friendly, safe manner.
