CLUBS & ACTIVITIES



Ambassador Program

Students in grades 3–8 serve as Student Ambassadors, acting as role models for their classmates and assisting with the school's Kindness Program.

Aviation Club

Second grade students explore the inspiring world of flight through hands-on interactive demonstrations, crafts, and games.

Award-winning Band (grades 4-8)

Students compete in the annual Diocesan Band Day competition and Music in the Park festival, and perform a winter and spring concert.

Chess Club

Students meet after school to learn how to play chess and compete against other Chess Club members.

Creation Care Club

Fourth grade students organize activities related to the care of our environment within our school and local community.

CYO Sports

Teams are organized and sponsored by All Saints parish and compete against other parishes in the Diocese. Sports include basketball, cross-country, track & field, and girls volleyball.

National Junior Honor Society (NJHS)

Qualified students are selected as NJHS members by majority vote of the faculty council. NJHS sponsors many events at All Saints throughout the school year.

Robotics Club

Our middle school students learn VEX robotics programming as part of the technology curriculum during school hours. All Saints also offers students an after school Robotics Club for those interested in learning more and further developing their skills. All Saints hosts an annual Robotics tournament.

Safety Patrols (grades 5-6)

Patrols greet students and ensure that they enter and exit the parking area and school safely each day.

Schola (grades 5-8)

Student members sing and play musical instruments at our weekly school Mass and special events throughout the school year.

All Saints students participate in Trail Life USA Troop 1188 for boys and American Heritage Girls Troop 1188 for girls. Both groups begin at age five.

Student Council Association (SCA)

Student representatives are elected by peers from each class in grades 4-8. The group sponsors activities throughout the year.
