During the 2024-2025 school year, All Saints will once again participate in Title I, a federally funded initiative that provides instructional services to benefit elementary level students in reading and math. In order to qualify for the program, students must be residents of the City of Manassas or live within the jurisdiction of a Title I zoned school in Prince William County and meet specific academic criteria.

Mrs. Ginger Spetsios will serve as our Title I teacher again this year. This week Mrs. Spetsios and the classroom teachers are finalizing the referral process for students who meet the program criteria and will be sending permission slips to parents.

As we focus on differentiation in our classrooms, Title I continues to be a highly effective program for us in that it specifically targets the learning needs of students. Should you have any questions about this program or your child's eligibility, please do not hesitate to contact the office for more information.

This week we have begun NWEA Map Testing for students in grades 3-7, a process that will be completed by September 27. Remember to look for details from the teachers regarding the dates and times of test sessions so that you can ensure that your children arrive to school on time, well rested, and ready to put forth their best effort in support of this important assessment.

Background Checks – Policies for School Parent Volunteers

As part of the diocesan initiative to maintain a safe environment for all of our children, all volunteers in the school are required to complete a background check prior to working in the school and to complete VIRTUS training within 45 days after their application has been approved.

In accordance with diocesan policy, full compliance for an adult parent volunteer is not required for *open* events. (An open event is one that is open to the public, infrequent and publicized, such as Field Day, concerts, and special events/assemblies.) However, full compliance is required for adult parent volunteers who wish to participate in closed events. (A closed event is one that is not entirely open to the general public such as classroom activities, parties, field trips, etc.) For this reason, all parents who wish to attend field trips or volunteer in support of classroom activities are required to complete the background check process and attend VIRTUS

training. The online application for the diocesan background check can be found at the following link:

VIRTUS trainings are held throughout the year at parishes and schools throughout the diocese and are free of charge to all participants. An email is generated to register for the training once an individual has completed the online criminal background check application and it has been approved by Mrs. Cristina Jimenez, our parish and school's liaison. Individuals are required by Diocesan policy to complete this adult safe environment training within 45 days after their application has been approved.
