Principal's Message

During the month of September, students in grades 3-7 completed the first round of NWEA Map Testing, the standardized testing program used throughout the diocese. The following is a summary of grade level achievement scores in the three subject areas of reading, math, and language arts. Each of the scores represents the national percentile ranking which is based upon the median score of each grade level when compared to the national norm group. For example, a National Percentile (NPR) of 67 would mean that the student group scored above 67% of their grade-level peers in the national norm group.

Nearly all of the grade level scores exceed 50 percentile which represents the national average in the norm group. I am very proud of our students for their strong performance on this first assessment of the year and grateful for all that our teachers continue to do to create an environment that fosters growth and learning.

Two weeks ago, the teachers began a review of their individual class profiles which they are now using to guide instruction for the remainder of the year. Teachers will be striving to differentiate instruction, particularly in math, to address the learning needs of their students. Our goal is for students to meet or exceed their projected learning targets for the academic year.




