I am pleased to announce that she returned to All Saints on Monday and has resumed her role as middle school advanced math teacher and 6<sup>th</sup> grade homeroom teacher.

On behalf of the school community, I wish to extend my heartfelt thanks and appreciation to Mrs. Short who served as the long-term substitute teacher for Mrs. Stowell and who completed her time in this role on Friday. I remain grateful for her strong commitment to the students and for all that she has done to launch the advanced math program this year.

This week we congratulate Mrs. Brink and her husband on the birth of their daughter on Friday evening. I am pleased to share with you that both Mrs. Brink and her little one are doing well, and she remains grateful for the prayers and support of our school community.

Mrs. Brink officially began her time of leave on Monday and we are continuing to finalize the details of a plan to provide continued support for students in grades 4-8, who are served by the Resource Program. As I have not yet been able to hire a long-term substitute resource teacher, I am pleased to announce that Mrs. Short will be working in the program on a part-time basis to provide testing accommodations and other support services for students as I continue to seek a substitute teacher for this role. 
