Principal's Message:

This week I wish to provide an important update regarding the safe environment training program at All Saints. In accordance with national initiatives and diocesan policy, for many years we have taken steps to ensure that your children are in a safe place when they are participating in a program at All Saints Catholic School. In support of this commitment, students in grades K-8 have participated in the *Formation in Christian Chastity* program.

During the summer, Bishop Burbidge approved the discontinuation of this curriculum as an approved safe environment program to meet the Diocesan annual training requirement. In accordance with this change, All Saints will implement the diocesan-approved *Circle of Grace* program beginning this year. This curriculum, which provides unique lessons for every grade, has already been in use in a number of schools in our diocese and has been well-established as a safe environment training option.

We will be integrating the objectives of the program into religion lessons in the weeks ahead beginning on Tuesday, November 12. Tomorrow, I will send an email to parents with additional information about the program, including an overview and key concepts. In the meantime, a link to the program that provides access to a Sample Curriculum that highlights the objectives for each grade level lesson can be found below.

(Note: The *Parent First* flyers that are accessible for each grade level are designed for parents only and will not be reviewed in class. They are designed as a resource so that you can determine the pertinent aspects that you may wish to share with your children.)

New Student Applications & Continuous Enrollment (2025-2026)

Applications for new students for academic year 2025-2026 are now available online. All current families who wish to enroll a *new student* in grades Pre-Kindergarten through eight for the upcoming year may access the application at the link below.

In January we will provide a copy of the *Continuous Enrollment Contract* to parents of students completing their first year of enrollment at All Saints. Through completion of this form, parents may continuously enroll their child/ren through 8th grade at All Saints or, if necessary, until such time that they complete the withdrawal process. With submission of this contract, there is no need for future completion of an annual re-registration form.

The Continuous Enrollment Fee will automatically be billed through FACTS accounts on March 3, 2025. The completion of the contract, for first year families, and payment of the fee will confirm enrollment for your child/ren for the upcoming school year.
