### Principal's Message:

This week I am pleased to share with you an update regarding the *Design for Excellence* Five Year Plan for our school and the goals that we have identified for 2024-2025. The Five Year Plan is a compilation of the goals from the self-study process and reaccreditation visit that occurred during the 2021-2022 school year.

The following is a list of goals for Year 3 (2024-2025).

- Strengthened efforts to assist parents in their role as the primary educators of their children by offering additional opportunities for evangelization and faith formation. (Completed in Year I & II)
- 2. Design and implement a process and timeline using a variety of tools to more consistently monitor, review, and evaluate student learning through data analysis in support of continuous improvement of curriculum and instruction.
- 3. Collaborate through Professional Learning Communities to monitor individual and class-wide student learning through the use of common assessments and rubrics.
- 4. Explore ways to increase revenue through the Annual Fund to \$25,000 by expanding participation levels across donor groups.

5. Review and select an updated mathematics program to include textbooks, digital resources, and manipulatives. (Deferred from Year I to coincide with Diocesan Curriculum Review Timeline.)

In the months ahead, I'll provide periodic updates as we work to complete these goals. In the meantime, should you have any questions about our Five Year Plan, please do not hesitate to let me know.

This week I also wish to provide an important update regarding our first grade program.

In anticipation of the birth of her baby, Mrs. Boddie has determined that her last day of teaching will be Tuesday, November 26. She has also decided that she will be resigning from her position at All Saints and not returning to the classroom to teach for the remainder of the 2024-2025 academic year.

We thank Mrs. Boddie for her outstanding work and for all that she has done to provide her students with a challenging yet supportive faith-filled environment each day. We congratulate her on the upcoming birth of her child and wish her every continued success and blessing.

I am pleased to announce that Ms. Mary Tremblay has accepted the offer to teach first grade and will begin employment at All Saints on Monday, January 6, following the Christmas holiday. Ms. Tremblay earned a Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education from Benedictine College where she completed her student teaching at the kindergarten grade level. Most recently, she has served as a substitute teacher at a Catholic school in New York. With a deep commitment to the Catholic faith, a joyful spirit, and a core belief that all students are capable of learning, she will be a great asset to our first grade program during the second half of the school year.

Since Ms. Tremblay will not begin teaching until January, Ms. Ayla Bazin will serve as the long-term substitute teacher during the month of December. As you may recall, Ms. Bazin joined our staff as a first grade instructional assistant in Mrs. Harrill's classroom at the beginning of the school year. She earned a Bachelor of Science in Elementary and Special Education from Mount St. Mary's University and looks forward to this three week teaching assignment and the opportunity to collaborate with Mrs. Harrill in the planning of instruction and assessments for the 1B class.

#### **Calendar Revisions - December**

A clarification from the Vatican to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has indicated that the transfer of the *Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary*, from Sunday, December 8 to Monday, December 9 is a holy day of obligation. For this reason, there will be a school Mass on December 9 at 8:30 a.m. (*Note: The Advent Penance Service originally scheduled for grades 6-8 for that same day has been postponed to Wednesday, December 11.)*

## 2025-2026 Application Link for New Students

In January we will provide a copy of the *Continuous Enrollment Contract* to parents of students completing their first year of enrollment at All Saints. Through completion of this form, parents may continuously enroll their child/ren through 8<sup>th</sup> grade at All Saints or, if necessary, until such

time that they complete the withdrawal process. With submission of this contract, there is no need for future completion of an annual re-registration form.

The Continuous Enrollment Fee will automatically be billed through FACTS accounts on March 3, 2025. The completion of the contract, for first year families, and payment of the fee will confirm enrollment for your child/ren for the upcoming school year.
