Tomorrow our school and parish will host a workshop for school leaders and enrollment professionals across the diocese in the Parish Activities Center. Coordinated by the Office of Catholic Schools, the session will include presentations by Mr. Lincoln Snyder, former President of the National Catholic Education Association and currently a Senior Partner at Partners in Mission, and Mr. William Kelly, President of Christopher Newport University. The focus for the day will be on creating a customercentric culture. I look forward to attending this informative session with a team from All Saints as we gather with colleagues from diocesan schools for this day of learning.

One of the cornerstones of Catholic education is a commitment to excellence in all things. And one of the ways that we strive to maintain such an environment is by regularly seeking your feedback regarding your level of satisfaction with your experience of our school.
