Principal's Message:

With only one week remaining until Graduation Day (June 6), we are finalizing plans for what will be a beautiful celebration of the success of our 8th grade students. The following is a schedule of special events planned for that day for the Class of 2025.

Pass-it-On Ceremony (Church/9:30 a.m.) - The students will gather in the church at 9:30 a.m. to observe the Pass-it-On Ceremony, an annual tradition and prayer service during which the 8th grade students "pass on" their leadership role to the rising 7th grade class as symbolized by the handing on of the 8th grade honor medals.

Graduation Breakfast (Father Kelly Hall/10:00 a.m.) – This graduates only event is a tradition during which the students will enjoy breakfast served by the pastor, school administration, and 8th grade teachers. At the conclusion of the meal, memories will be shared, gifts presented, and final report cards distributed to the students.

8th Grade Walk of Honor (Courtyard/11:00 a.m.) – Following the breakfast, the graduates will process individually from Father Kelly Hall while all of the students in grades K-7 line the hallways and applaud each one as they exit the building for the final time as students.

Graduation Mass & Ceremony (Church/4:00 p.m.) – All school families and members of our community are cordially invited to attend the Graduation Mass & Ceremony, followed by a reception in the Parish Activities Center.

Important Reminder: As Graduation will begin at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, June 6, school will dismiss at noon for students in grades K-7. Extended Day services will remain available.

Reminders from the Nurse

Medication pick up will be available the last two days of school. Please check in with Mrs. Kruppa before going to the nurse's office to pick up any medication. Any remaining medication will be kept at the front desk until end of the day Monday, June 16th and then disposed of, in accordance with diocesan policy.

Please remember that rising 7th Graders will need the mandatory Meningococcal and Tdap vaccines for entry to the new school year. Kindly include their annual School Health Entrance Form with these immunizations listed. All rising Kindergartners will need a new School Health Entrance Form and immunizations for the new school year.

NOTE: While Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten and 7th Grade students require a new School Health Entrance Form before the first day of school, students in Kindergarten through 8th grade need to submit a Confidential Health History form, and ALL grades should provide a School Health Entrance form following their annual school physical annually to ensure up to date care of your child.

• FACTS Tuition – Payment Plans (2025-2026)

As we make plans for the upcoming school year, one of our priorities is that of continuing to provide as much tuition assistance as possible for families in our community. In support of this effort, we have submitted applications on behalf of our school families for funding through the Diocese of Arlington Scholarship Foundation and the St. Beatrice Special Tuition Assistance Program. Diocesan allocations related to these sources of tuition assistance will be confirmed over the course of this month. As we receive this information, we will finalize decisions regarding tuition assistance and notify those families who have applied for financial aid accordingly.

Last week we finalized FACTS payment plans for the 2025-2026 school year. Please note that the balance due does not yet reflect any tuition assistance allocations. Once tuition assistance awards are confirmed, we will notify families who have applied and adjust the corresponding payment plans accordingly. We anticipate completing this process by early June.

Reminder: The deadline for payment in full with a 2% discount is Tuesday, June 10.
