A Note from the Nurse

Dear Parents and Guardians:

As the fall/winter approaches the incidence of illnesses will naturally go up. To help alleviate more simple illness symptoms you may choose to give your child an over the counter (OTC) medication. Per policy, your child is not permitted to carry any medications with them during school, this includes any over the counter (OTC) medications or cough drops. If you wish your child to have access to OTC medications during the school day, for example cough drops, Tums, Tylenol, or Motrin, these will have to be provided by you and brought to the front office. You will need to fill out a F6 Medication Authorization form (attached to this email). I will be able to store them in the clinic and give them to your child, as prescribed on the medication packaging.

- **Registration for the 2025-2026 Boys and Girls CYO Basketball season is open from September 15 through October 12, 2025.**
