Principal's Message:

This week our school is participating in the Diocesan Week of Service (November 9-16), an initiative that has encouraged parishes and schools to put *Love in Action through Service in Community*. In support of this effort, I am pleased to share that students in Grades K-8 recently assisted in the creation of individual cards, many of which included an offering of prayers, which are being delivered by parish volunteers to shut-ins in the local Manassas community. I am grateful to our students, who through their encouraging words and prayers, have lifted the hearts of approximately 300 individuals in the region.

In accordance with national initiatives and diocesan policy, for many years we have taken steps to ensure that your children are in a safe place when they are participating in a program at All Saints Catholic School. In support of this commitment, our school has implemented the diocesan-approved *Circle of Grace* program. This curriculum, which provides unique lessons for grades K-8, has been in use in our diocese for a number of years and has been well-established as a safe environment training option.

We will be integrating the objectives of the program into religion lessons in the weeks ahead beginning on Monday, November 17.

Tomorrow I will send an email to parents with additional information about the program, including an overview and key concepts. In the meantime, a link to the program that provides access to a sample curriculum that highlights the objectives for each grade level lesson can be found below.

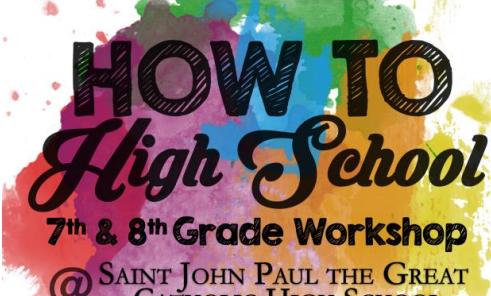

In January we will provide a copy of the *Continuous Enrollment Contract* to parents of students completing their first year of enrollment at All Saints. Through completion of this form, parents may continuously enroll their child/ren through 8th grade at All Saints or, if necessary, until such time that they complete the withdrawal process. With submission of this contract, there is no need for future completion of an annual re-registration form.

The Continuous Enrollment Fee will automatically be billed through FACTS accounts on March

2, 2026. The completion of the contract, for first year families, and payment of the fee will confirm enrollment for your child/ren for the upcoming school year.
