Message from the School Nurse – Flu Update

Respiratory illnesses are listed as high (minimal- extremely high) in Northern Virginia according to the Virginia Department of Health, with influenza A dominating recorded ER visits. We have had at least one documented case in each classroom at All Saints. Influenza is contagious starting at least a day before symptoms show and up to 4-7 days after becoming sick. The typical incubation period for influenza is 1-4 days (average: 2 days). Symptoms typically develop quickly and include body aches, chills, fever, fatigue, headache. With some individuals there is nausea and vomiting.

Unfortunately, flu vaccination rates this year are one of the lowest on record. Getting vaccinated protects not just you and your family, but also other students or staff who may be vulnerable. Influenza generally circulates through March so it's not too late to get your flu shot.

Please keep your child home if he/she is acting sick or has a temperature above 100 degrees. A child must be fever free for 24 hours prior to returning to school and any cough should be improving. 24 hours should also pass after a child experiences vomiting or bouts of diarrhea and they are able to eat a normal meal.

Reporting a positive test to the nurse or school office is helpful in tracking illness. Flu tests are available at your local drug store or seek advice/care from your child's doctor. In the meantime, remind your child to wash their hands frequently and cough in their elbow.

Lastly, we recognize how important academics are and understand that students may worry about missing tests or assignments. At the same time, a student's health must come first. If your student is not feeling well, please keep him or her home, allowing time for rest and recovery. Sending a child to school can be stressful for the student and may put others at risk.

Thank you for your partnership in helping us keep our school community healthy. I wish you good health.




