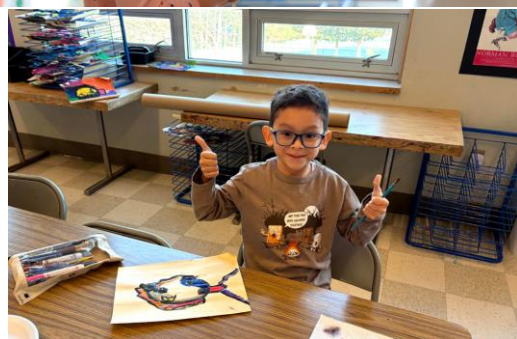
I wish to extend a special word of thanks to everyone who supported our online learning efforts. I am grateful, in particular, to the faculty & staff who with creativity and enthusiasm truly set the tone for the week. I am also thankful to the many parents who took time from their busy schedules to assist their children in navigating the online learning sessions. Without your guidance, the transition to virtual learning would not have been possible.

With 98% of our students participating in online learning and a fairly typical rate of absenteeism per day, we were able to maintain the learning momentum. Additionally, since we used only one of the three snow days built-into our academic calendar, it is not necessary that we revise our schedule at this time. Again, thank you to everyone who contributed to the success of our pivot to online learning.

This week I wish to also provide an update regarding our first grade program. I'm pleased to share that Mrs. Partridge, who has been working in the role of substitute instructional assistant for the past two weeks in 1A, has accepted the position of instructional assistant for the remainder of the academic year and will be working 32-40 hours per week. As evidenced through the experience of online learning, Mrs. Harrill and Mrs. Partridge have established a wonderful partnership and I am

delighted that Mrs. Partridge will be continuing in her role, supporting our first graders in the learning process.

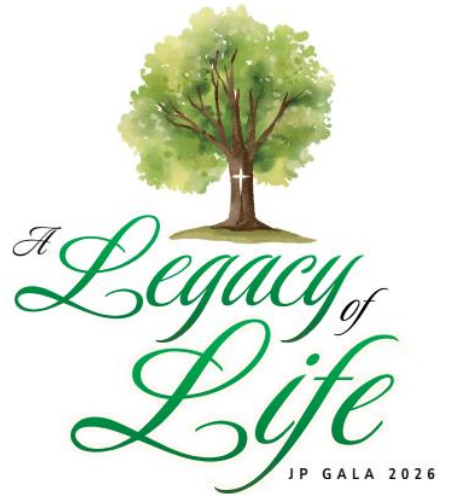
